## Executive Board – Position Description

### **Government Affairs Committee / Chairperson**

- 1) Service.
  - a) Term is for one year, July 1 to June 30.
  - b) Multiple terms are allowed.
  - c) Chair may establish committee.
  - d) Position is appointed by President.
- 2) Purpose.
  - a) Serves as the communication network between the chapter and ASSE HQ regarding governmental affairs and activities.
- 3) Goals.
  - a) Coordinate legislative actions involving local, state, regional and national issues impacting the safety profession.
  - b) Provide input on federal laws and regulations on which ASSE is proposing to comment.
  - c) Meet (Governmental Affairs Committee) on a regular basis during the Chapter year and provide at least quarterly reports to the Chapter Executive Committee.
  - d) Support a Chapter member belonging to a National/State legislative affairs committee related to safety, health and environment and attend at least 3 meetings.
  - e) Host State or National legislative leaders. Again my ignorance. How will they accomplish this? – Good question, from existing LRP

- f) Develop and distribute promotional materials to all members to increase their participation in legislative affairs.
- g) Assist the Chapter, by itself or with another Society unit, to sponsor a local or state legislation. Legislation must be co-sponsored by a current legislator.
- h) Assist in the process that Chapter legislation becomes law.
- i) Develop a Chapter position paper on local/state affairs as well as developing a program to introduce/promote the Chapter/Society to legislators.
